- **E.** Armchair Traveller Kathy is working on this. We are hoping to procure a couple hundred dollars from the proceeds. (shared with Rec Society)
- **F.** BC Hydro 2020 application due March 31st. In our application, we should include different requests than last year, eg. metal boxes for trailer, chain saw, hose drying rack—Kathy will go online for info, ask Koot Fluid or

- Acklands for info. The \$500 BC Hydro funding from last year needs to be used up by end of May. Kathy will submit application. Last year's money has to be spent by May 31st.
- **G.** RDEK/CBT no further funding applied for (Jan 31st deadline) this year because we have not spent all of 2019-20 yet. Jane suggested we apply for \$2500 Grant In Aid in May to complete the shelter, not before. Make the scope broader than previously.
- **H.** WASP sales fund raiser will continue this year. Debbie moved to order 10 for sale. Seconded by Sharon. Carried.
- I. Firesmart Canada application has been submitted for an event in 2020. Although Terry indicated he was supportive of our event, he could not specify exactly how much funding the RDEK could provide.

Terry has submitted a Section 52 application to use Crown Land and expects that process will be fairly quick. He thought lot would be ready to use by May.
